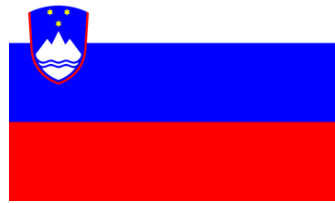
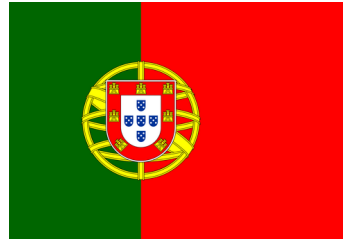

The topic of the project is analyzing the Social Media Behaviours of Teenagers in different countries and sharing the results.



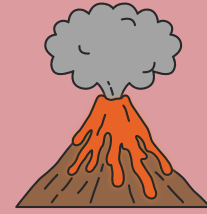
First day - 16.05.2022

Meeting in Messina

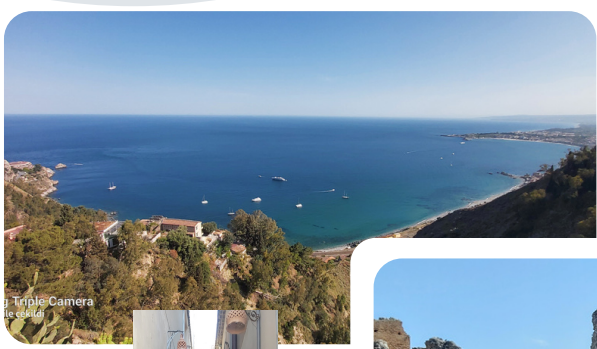
